# Western Waters District, Michigan Conference UMC PROPOSED 2025 BUDGET

### Income:

- District Ministry Shares: \$155,000 (no more than 6% increase over 2024).
- Muskegon Methodist Ministry Shares: \$4,480 (\$4 per person x # members). Only Muskegon County churches pay into this, although anyone can make a donation.
- Conference Grant: \$25,000 for the Native American Elders Program (see below).

# TOTAL INCOME: \$197,480

### Expense:

- Youth and Young Adult Ministries: \$10,000 support for youth and college ministries.
- Native American Elders Program (NAEP): \$53,250 nutritional meals and programming for Native American Senior Citizens. Note: \$25,000 is provided by a conference grant (see above).
- Mission Support Grants include NECOM, SECOM, Immigration Law and Justice (formerly JFON), La Nueva Esperanza UMC, Thrive Refugee resettlement, MAPS, Pathfinders, UMCH, Family Promise of the Lakeshore.
- Grants are available for local church missions, technology, leadership development and disaster response.
- DS Discretionary Fund: \$10,500 to be utilized when emergencies and needs develop, long-term funding solutions must go through the grant process.
- Admin: \$22,100 insurance, supplies, staff, technology and leadership training events, retreats, and programs for laity and clergy, including Lay Servant Ministries.
